

CONTACT LENS POLICY AND PROFESSIONAL FEES

The first step in finding the best contacts for you is to schedule for a comprehensive eye exam and contact lens fitting. This is to make sure your eyes are healthy enough to wear contact lenses and counsel you about what to expect when wearing contacts.

If you have insurance coverage: Most insurance plans cover for routine eye exam this is to determine prescription for glasses and evaluate the health of your eyes. Contact lens service is a separate procedure that is **often not covered** by insurances.

During the contact lens fitting process, detailed measurements of your eyes are taken, and trial lenses are applied to achieve the best possible fit and determine if you can comfortably wear contacts.

A contact lens fitting takes more than a single visit. You will be asked to return for follow-up visits to make sure the lenses continue to fit properly and remain comfortable after prolonged periods of wear. In some cases, changes of lens size or design are needed before the fitting process is complete.

Contact lens fitting fee: Cost depends on the type of contact lenses the doctor recommends appropriate for you, this ranges from \$55 dollars for an established patient to refill the same prescription to \$600 dollars for a new contact lens fit for medical necessity. The fee will cover all related follow-up visits and is **non-refundable** once the fitting process has begun.

Your prescription for contact lens is written only after the contact lens fitting process is completed and is valid for 12 months.
